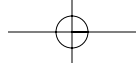

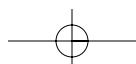

Lively Technical Center originally opened with one full-time and one half-time instructor and 52 students. The school now serves thousands of students annually. Lively's main campus is conveniently located at 500 North Appleyard Drive, Tallahassee, Florida with an aviation campus located at the Tallahassee Regional Airport. Lively also offers dual enrollment programs at Chiles, Lincoln, Rickards, and Wakulla High School. Part-time career enhancement courses for city, county, and state governmental agencies, as well as private businesses, are often held at the hosts' own facilities. Lively Technical Center is part of the Leon County School district and is overseen by Superintendent Jackie Pons, but is designated by the Florida State Board of Education to serve the broader region encompassing Leon, Gadsden, and Wakulla counties.

Lively Technical Center welcomes the opportunity to serve adults and teens from North Florida, neighboring South Georgia and Alabama. The student body is as diverse as the world in which we live. Classes are designed to provide individualized training in appropriately scaled class sizes that allow a more personally focused approach by educators. The faculty is composed of highly qualified educators within their discipline, each possessing a wide range of proficiency in technical fields which allows them to bring practical experiential learning to the classroom. Along with dedicated staff, the faculty is committed to serving students and enhancing learning through a combination of educational opportunities and relevant work experiences. This broad range of expertise ensures Lively's ability to provide students with the career knowledge, on-the-job training, positive work attitudes, and employability skills that lead to a successful career.

Lively Technical Center utilizes a variety of educational delivery methods, including classroom lecture, computer-assisted instruction, audio-visual instruction, hands-on learning opportunities, one-on-one instruction, internships and externships, cooperative education/on-the-job training and

apprenticeship. Some courses require students to achieve competency in skills within a specified timeframe, while many other courses are individualized, self-paced programs that allow students to progress and achieve competency in skills according to their abilities. As a component of the hands-on learning approach, Lively offers real world training opportunities to our students through services provided to the community such as cosmetology, barbering, catering and photography. Hybrid learning is a new and innovative option enabling students to blend traditional and distance learning as a powerful combination for continued training via the internet. Hybrid learning technology allows students who continue employment while enrolled the opportunity to work at their convenience in the comfort of their home. The school is continuously adding new and exciting learning opportunities to meet the growing demand for workforce training. For example, the Lively Automotive Program will be training new mechanics in compressed natural gas installation, a process that converts regular gas-powered vehicles to utilize cleaner and more economical natural gas. This is just one of many new and exciting training opportunities being introduced.

Lively Technical Center, in partnership with the extended community, empowers students for success in a career-focused education. Lively is accredited through the Council on Occupational Education and is approved for training by a variety of State Agencies. As the needs of our community change, Lively Technical Center strives to meet the new demands of the workplace by offering a variety of business, computer, trade-based and health education programs. Students begin learning in their desired field from the first day of class and are ready for job placement at the completion of their program. While offering diverse training opportunities, Lively still strives to serve students as individuals and meet specific needs for potential success.
