



Administration of Intravenous Therapy for Licensed Practical Nurses



30-Hour Certificate Course

The 30-hour course meets the requirements for the licensed practical nurse (LPN) to initiate, care for peripheral intravenous lines and to care for central lines. The course may be taken by LPNs, graduate PNs (Students need to provide an official certificate of graduation), or by registered nurses who would like to enhance their IV skills. A course notebook will be provided on the first day of class. Students who successfully complete the class will receive a certificate of completion.

Florida Administrative Code 64B9-12.005: *Clinical competence. The course must be followed by supervised clinical practice in intravenous therapy as needed to demonstrate clinical competence. Verification of clinical competence shall be the responsibility of each institution employing a licensed practical nurse based on institutional protocol. Such verification shall be given through a signed statement of a Florida licensed registered nurse.*
